

Key Safety Standards



We ask that you observe the safety standards below. These standards are to assist in managing the risks of hazards to those working on the Boatyard.

- No cradle arm, block or prop shall be removed or repositioned by anyone other than trained Boatyard Staff. Any breach of this rule will be reported to club management and can result in the banning from the use of the yard facilities.
- Safety Vest must be worn at all times Monday to Friday.
- All correct Personal Protection Equipment to be worn at all times (e.g. covered shoes, gloves, masks).
- All lifting, moving, blocking, standing and water blasting shall be undertaken by the Club staff only.
- Maintain no less than 5 metres clearance distance from moving machinery. Before moving, operator will blast horn.
- Scaffolding to be used when working above 1.8 metres. Ladders not to be used as a working platform.
- A harness must be used above 1 metre.
- Mast crane may only be used by those authorised by the Boatyard Manager. The mast crane requires training and experience.
- The water blaster is to be strictly used by RPAYC Staff only. The gurney is not to be used on the Boatyard.
- No head phones to be used whilst on Boatyard.
- Children under the age of 12 are not permitted on the Boatyard.
- Skateboards, bikes, ball games or playing on hard stand is prohibited.
- Animals are not permitted on the boatyard.
- There is No Smoking permitted on the hardstand
