

# Boatyard User Check Lists



All boxes to be checked by Boatyard User

Boatyard User acknowledges that they have read and understood the Rules and Key Safety Standards of the boatyard.

No cradle arm, block or prop shall be removed or repositioned by anyone other than trained Boatyard Staff. Any breach of this rule will be reported to club management and can result in the banning from the use of the yard facilities.

The hard stand is an industrial area. Children under the age of 12 years are not permitted on the boatyard. (Skateboards, bikes, ball games or playing on hard stand is prohibited).

If children over the age of 12 years will be accompanying boatyard user's, the boatyard user must take full responsibility and supervise the child(ren) at all times.

Work is not to be performed on deck (above gunnell) or super structure whilst vessel is on hard stand without a safety harness. (Limited Safety harnesses available for use from Boatyard Office or DockMaster when Boatyard Office is closed).

The Boatyard is a dirty work site and it is likely that dust and dirt will be present on the decks following its time on the yard. It is recommended that you wash your vessel upon completion of work. The Club will not accept the responsibility of cleaning any vessel other than those vessels where the club has performed the antifoul.

The boatyard user acknowledges that they have been shown the location of emergency contact details .

The Boatyard user agrees to minimise water usage. All water is recycled on the boatyard, do not drink.

The boatyard user is responsible to ensure their own electrical & safety equipment is in safe working order.

The boatyard user agrees that others who may join him/her to assist will be made aware of the Rules and Key Safety Standards of the Slipway. Waterfront staff can be called at any time via the Reception to provide instruction and clarification.

All outside contractors must supply to Reception, prior to beginning a project, their Public Risk Policy which must be a minimum sum insured of \$10,000,000, as well as a copy of workers compensation

Limited equipment is available for use and boatyard users are asked to cooperate with on another to ensure access is available to everyone.

All boatyard users agree to take direction from RPAYC Slipway Staff.
