

SECTION 14.0 - TWO HANDED & WOMEN'S WINTER POINTSCORE SERIES – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1 RULES

- 1.1 RRS 52 Manual power is altered to allow the use of electronic steering devices and powered winches only. This includes wind-powered devices.
- 1.2 RRS 51 MOVING BALLAST is deleted.
- 1.3 At times of heightened risk, lifejackets and harnesses must be worn by both crew members in the Two Handed division. Harness tethers must be attached to clipping points or a jackstay when any crew member is on a working deck.
- 1.4 For Women's Winter Series, boats shall be crewed by women, except that one (1) male crew is permitted onboard. This crewman shall not helm the boat whilst racing.

2 RESPONSIBILITY

- 2.1 All those taking part in RPAYC races do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- 2.2 Attention is drawn to the Racing Rules of Sailing, Fundamental Rule 4, which states **"The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone"**.

4 DIVISION FLAGS

4.1 There shall be two (2) divisions. Division flags shall be as follows:

Division	Flag Displayed
Two-Handed - Division 1	Code Flag "R"
Women's - Division 2	

5 THE START

- 5.1 The starting area may be the area of water extending from Bayview in the South to an imaginary line extending east from Longnose Point in the North.
- 5.2 The starting line will be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and the course side of an orange inflatable mark on the port end of the line.

6 STARTING TIMES

6.1 The scheduled start time is:

Division	Scheduled Start Time
All Divisions	1000hrs

7 THE FINISH

- 7.1 The finish line shall be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and an orange inflatable mark moored nearby.
- 7.2 The finishing line may be located in the vicinity of the starting area.

8 SHORTENING COURSE

8.1 As per Section 3 - General Notice of Race 16.1.

9 TIME LIMIT

9.1 The time limit shall be 1400hrs.



10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Two Handed Pointscore Series shall consist of up to four (4) races.
- 10.2 The Women's Winter Pointscore Series shall consist of up to four (4) races.
- 10.3 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes may be awarded for each race to the first, second and third place getters for each division in each race scheduled.
- 11.2 Series Pointscore prizes may be awarded for first, second and third place at the Annual Presentation.

12 COURSES

- 12.1 The courses to be sailed shall be selected from the entire list contained in RPAYC List of Courses 2017-2018.
- 12.2 The course shall be displayed from the Race Committee Signal Boat at or before the Warning Signal for each division' start.
- 12.3 All marks are to be rounded to starboard unless otherwise indicated (P), denoting a port rounding.
