

SECTION 7.0 - WOMEN'S TWILIGHT POINTSCORE SERIES – SUPPLEMENTRY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1 RULES

- 1.1 Women's Twilight Pointscore Series is open to Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker boats.
- 1.2 Boats electing to compete Non Spinnaker (NS) in the Women's Twilight Series do so as per Section 3 - General Notice of Race 19. Only a mainsail and a headsail as defined in RRS 50.4 shall be used.
- 1.3 Boats shall be crewed by women, except that one (1) male crew is permitted onboard. This crewman shall not helm the boat whilst racing.
- 1.4 At times of heightened risk, lifejackets must be worn by all crew members.
- 1.5 Navigation lights must be correctly displayed between sunset and sunrise and/or in poor visibility.

2 RESPONSIBILITY

- 2.1 All those taking part in RPYC races do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- 2.2 Attention is drawn to the Racing Rules of Sailing, Fundamental Rule 4, which states **"The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone"**.

4 DIVISION FLAGS

4.1 There may be up to two (2) divisions. Division flags shall be as follows:

Division	Flag Displayed
Division 1	Numeral Pennant 1
Division 2	Numeral Pennant 2

4.2 Division allocation shall be provided prior to the first race.

5 THE START

5.1 The starting area may be the area of water extending from Bayview in the South to an imaginary line north of Scotland Island.

5.2 The starting line will be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and the course side of an orange inflatable mark on the port end of the line.

6 STARTING TIMES

6.1 The scheduled start times are:

Division 2	1755hrs
Division 1	1800hrs

7 THE FINISH

7.1 The finish line shall be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and an orange inflatable mark moored nearby.

7.2 The finishing area may be in the same vicinity as the starting area.

8 SHORTENING COURSE

8.1 As per Section 3 – General Notice of Race 16.1.

9 TIME LIMIT

9.1 The time limit shall be official sunset Sydney time (AEDT) as noted in the schedule of races.



10 SCORING

- 10.1 Women's Twilight Pointscore Series shall consist of up to ten (10) races.
- 10.2 When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3 When five (5) to nine (9) races have been completed a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4 When ten (10) races have been completed a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two (2) scores.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes may be awarded for each race to the first, second and third place getters for each division in each race scheduled.
- 11.2 Women's Twilight Pointscore Series prizes may be awarded for first, second and third place at the conclusion of the Series or at the Annual Presentation.

12 COURSES

- 12.1 The course to be sailed shall be selected from the entire list contained in RPAYC List of Courses 2017-2018.
- 12.2 The course shall be displayed from the Race Committee Signal Boat at or before the Warning Signal for each division.
- 12.3 All marks are to be rounded to starboard unless otherwise indicated (P), denoting a port rounding.
