

SECTION 9.0 - PITTWATER INSHORE SERIES AND CLASSIC BOATS SERIES – SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS



1 RULES

- 1.1 Boats electing to compete Non Spinnaker (NS) in the Pittwater Inshore Series and all boats in the Classic Boat Series do so as per Section 3 - General Notice of Race 19.
- 1.2 At times of heightened risk, lifejackets must be worn by all crew members.

2 RESPONSIBILITY

- 2.1 All those taking part in RPYC races do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- 2.2 Attention is drawn to the Racing Rules of Sailing, Fundamental Rule 4, which states **“The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone”**.

4 DIVISION FLAGS

4.1 Division flags shall be as follows:

Division No.1	Numeral Pennant 1
Division No.2	Numeral Pennant 2
Division No.3	Numeral Pennant 3
Division No.4 - Classics	Numeral Pennant 4

4.2 Division allocations shall be provided prior to the first race.

5 THE START

5.1 The starting area may be the area of water extending from Bayview in the South to an imaginary line extending east from Longnose Point in the North.

5.2 The starting line will be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and the course side of an orange inflatable mark on the port end of the line.

6 STARTING TIMES

6.1 The scheduled start times are:

7 THE FINISH

7.1 The finish line shall be between the signal mast on the Race Committee Signal Boat displaying an orange flag and an orange inflatable mark moored nearby.

7.2 The finishing line may be located in the vicinity of the starting line.

8 SHORTERNING COURSE

8.1 As per Section 3 – General Notice of Race 16.1



9 TIME LIMIT

- 9.1 The time limit shall be 1730hrs.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Pittwater Inshore Pointscore Series shall consist of up to nine (9) races.
- 10.2 The Classic Boats Series shall consist of up to nine (9) races.
- 10.3 When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 10.4 When five (5) to nine (9) races have been completed a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes may be awarded for each race to the first, second and third place getters for each division in each race scheduled.
- 11.2 Series Pointscore prizes may be awarded for first, second and third place at the Annual Presentation.

12 COURSES

- 12.1 The courses to be sailed shall be selected from the entire list contained in RPAYC List of Courses 2017-2018.
- 12.2 The course shall be displayed from the Race Committee Signal Boat at or before the Warning Signal for each division.
- 12.3 All marks are to be rounded to starboard unless otherwise indicated (P), denoting a port rounding.
