### ARRIVING AT RPAYC – PARKING

## SIGNING INTO THE CLUB

All non-member persons 18yrs or older are required to sign in as a temporary members of the RPAYC if entering the Club House. Visitors are required to carry their registration slip at all times in and around the club area. There is an electronic sign in book located at reception when you first walk in the main club house entrance that can issue a weekly visitors sign-in slip.

The route can travel north to Palm Beach and south all the way to “Wynyard” in the CBD. Buses generally come every half an hour, however check timetable online or at bus stop for more information outside of busy operating hours.
