#### 8 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 8.1 Notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board located adjacent to reception.
- 8.2 The Race Committee may broadcast race information on VHF 72 at any time. Failure of such communication to be given or received shall not be subject to redress nor is such information a breach of RRS 41. This changes RRS 41 and 62.1.

## 9 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 9.1 Changes to the schedule will be posted by 2000 on the day before they will take effect. Other changes will be posted before 0900hrs on the day they take effect.
- 9.2 Changes to the Sailing Instructions made afloat will be indicated by the display of Code Flag 3rd Substitute accompanied by two sound signals. This may be communicated orally.

#### 10 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 10.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the official flagstaff on the Sun Dial lawn at the club.
- 10.2 The Warning Signal will not be made less than 60 minutes after "AP" is lowered ashore. This changes RRS Race Signals "AP".

#### 11 AREAS THAT RANK AS OBSTRUCTIONS

11.1 While racing in Pittwater, boats shall not sail within the area of water between registered moorings (including Police or NSW Maritime moorings) and the adjacent shoreline inside Pittwater. These areas rank as obstructions.

## 12 SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 Support vessels shall render assistance to any boat in danger when requested by the boat or the Race Committee.
- 12.2 Except when complying with SI12.1, support vessels and personnel shall stay 100 metres outside the course area from the time of the first Warning Signal until all boats have finished racing.

### 13 TIME LIMIT

13.1 If no boat in a class or division sails the course and finishes within 75 minutes the race shall be abandoned.

#### 14 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 14.1 The protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat finishes in the last race of that day.
- 14.2 Notices will be posted no later than 20 minutes after the protest time limit informing competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- 14.3 The penalty, if any, for any infringement of the rules other than RRS Part 2 is at the sole discretion of the Protest Committee and may be other than disqualification. This changes RRS 64.1.
- 14.4 On the last day of the regatta a request for reopening a hearing or redress shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. Changes RRS 62.2.



### 15 CLASS / DIVISION FLAGS

- 15.1 The Class flag for Etchells is the Etchells Class flag OR Code Flag E.
- 15.2 The Class flag for 11m is numeral pennant 2.
- 15.3 The Class flag for Int 5.5m is numeral pennant 3.
- 15.4 The Class flag for the Elliott 7s and sports boats is numeral pennant 4.

### 16 MARKS, STARTING/FINISHING LINE

- 16.1 Mark 1 and the Gate marks shall be **yellow** inflatable marks.
- 16.2 Mark 1a (the offset mark), if laid, shall be a **red** inflatable mark.
- 16.3 The "Change Mark" shall be a **green** inflatable mark. When, in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it shall be replaced by an original **yellow** mark.
- 16.4 The starting and finishing lines shall be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and a **black and white checkered** inflatable mark.
- 16.5 The finishing vessel may be different to the starting vessel.

#### 17 COURSES

- 17.1 The course, compass bearing and approximate distance to Mark 1 shall be displayed by the Race Committee Boat.
- 17.2 Marks 1 and 1a shall be rounded to port. Mark 1a is an offset mark.
- 17.3 If one Gate mark is missing, boats shall round the existing mark to port.
- 17.4 Below is the description of the courses:

Code	Course	
C1	Course 1:	Start – 1 – 1a – Finish
C2	Course 2:	Start – 1 – 1a – Gate – 1 – 1a – Finish
C5	Course 5:	Start – 1 – 1a – Gate – 1 – 1a – Gate – Finish
