Category Definitions

The definitions of Inshore and Cat 7 are not the same – the Inshore is a little more demanding.

Inshore (I): These events are usually held in sheltered waters, or under conditions similar to those experienced in sheltered waters, during daylight hours, and involve passages less than two miles offshore. Boats must be prepared to meet emergencies without the expectation of external assistance in less than two hours. Cruises in the Pittwater and Broken Bay areas are considered examples of Inshore events. Where an Inshore event includes a bar crossing the boat and crew must comply with legislative requirements.

Category 7: Short races in sheltered waters, in daylight hours only and with effective rescue availability. Boats not complying with 3.01.3 are not required to carry buoyancy.
