MOLLY'S CRADLE WINES

- Start Time:** 1050 Two Handed Division & 1100 All Other Yachts
Each Division will Receive 5 mins prior - Warning Signal. 4 mins prior - Prep Signal, 60 seconds prior - 1 minute Warning Signal.
- Start:** Near the Palm Beach Pile and between the RMYC Committee boat and a laid buoy. Communications on VHF Channel 77 or mobile 0422 041 798
- Course:** Start – Lion Island (P) – Dangar Island (P) or (S) - Scotland Island (P) – Finish
- Finish:** Finish will be between RMYC tower and a mark laid approx. 300 metres west of the RMYC tower. **Note there will be a clearance flag mark on the Eastern side of the line that must be kept to Port.**
- Time Limit:** 5 hours
- COVID Safety:** Participants to adhere to their Club's COVID 19 Safety Plan.
- Presentation:** Presentation of prizes and notification of results will be held in the RMYC's Lounge Bar approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of the race.
- Entry (4 races):** \$95 RMYC & \$115 Non RMYC Member (GSC, HRYC & RPAYC through Club). Club Block \$95 per entrant (Minimum 5)
Casual \$30 per race.
- Entries:** Online entries must be submitted through Top Yacht Race Management programme at least TWO business days prior to the race. Use link below to Top Yacht <https://www.topyacht.com.au/db/kb/1401>
- A boat not entered on time will not receive a placing.**

NOTE: As payment of entry for HRYC, GSC, RPAYC & RMYC Club members is made through the relevant Clubs no payment is required when entering Online (Payment Options select by cash) and proceed with entry.

BROKEN BAY INTERCLUB CHALLENGE SERIES NOTICE OF RACE

1. THE SERIES

- 1.1 The Broken Bay Interclub Challenge Series consists of 4 races between RMYC, Gosford, Avalon, Hawkesbury River, Palm Beach & RPAYC Sailing Clubs and other eligible entrants. Owners of eligible boats are invited to enter on the conditions of this Notice of Race.
- 1.2 The races include, Three Island Race - Brooklyn Bash – Gosford Gallop and The Pittwater Pursuit
- 1.3 Clubs compete against each other to hold the Broken Bay Interclub Challenge trophy.
- 1.4 Unless entered as Non-Spinnaker, Spinnakers and other 'extras' may be used but are not compulsory.

2. THE RULES

- 2.1 Organising Authority is RMYC Broken Bay.
- 2.2 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of the International Sailing Federation, the RMYC Sailing Division Sailing Instructions (<https://www.royalmotor.com.au/boating-groups/sailing/sailing-instructions-notice-of-race>), this NOR and any subsequent modifications.
- 2.3 Boats are required to comply with Special Regulations Category 7, the Boating (Safety Equipment) Regulations of NSW and must hold a current Safety Equipment Compliance Form.
- 2.4 A boat lodging a Protest must lodge the Protest Form (<https://www.royalmotor.com.au/boating-groups/sailing/sailing-forms>) or Club Protest Form at the RMYC office within one hour of the last boat finishing. The boat must advise the Race Officer of their intention to lodge a protest.

3. SCORING

- 3.1 The Broken Bay Interclub Challenge Series winning club is the club with the lowest score calculated by adding together the scores of the three best boat handicap results of each club per race. Low Scoring system will apply.
- 3.2 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A – Low Point System Scoring and as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 3.3 Handicapping will be in accordance with the handicap system of RMYC Sailing Division.

4. PRIZES

- 4.1 Prizes are awarded to the best performing yachts on handicap.
- 4.2 Presentation of prizes and notification of results for each race of the Series will be approximately 1 hour after the conclusion of the races.
- 4.3 Prizes not collected at the time will be forfeited to the next placed boat that is in attendance at the presentation.

5. TROPHIES

- 5.1 The RMYC Perpetual Combined (Whizzbang) Trophy will be awarded to the RMYC boat with the lowest point score of the four races in the Broken Bay Interclub Challenge Series on Presentation Night but remain at RMYC.
- 5.2 The winning club will receive The BBIC Interclub Club Trophy which is perpetual
