Summer Centreboard Series 2021-2022

The Centreboard Committee has received a number of requests to review the scores in Rounds 1, 2, & 3 of the Summer Centreboard Series, *for the competitors that failed to meet the requirements of NoR 3.6 and or SI 19.0.*

Reinstating any of the boats scored DSQ in accordance with NoR 3.6 and or SI 19.0 will worsen many other competitors scores through no fault of their own; as such in order to reinstate any boats that have been scored DSQ the Organising Authority require **unanimous agreement**, in writing, from the effected sailors in the effected classes.

“I **agree** that competitors scored DSQ under NoR 3.6 and or SI 19.0 for Rounds 1-3 shall have their race results reinstated nor those races rescored”

OR

“I **do not agree** that competitors scored DSQ under NoR 3.6 and or SI 19.0 for Rounds 1-3 shall have their race results reinstated nor those races rescored”

All competitors in such Fleets will need submit their answer by Sunday 14 November, 2021, 1200hrs.

If we do not have unanimous agreement or competitors opt out of replying the DSQ's shall remain.

NoR 3.6 and SI 19.0 shall continue to apply.

The result of the decision shall not be subject to requests for Redress where a boats score has been made worse, this amends RRS62.1.
