A separate Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, as published by the RMYC, will govern the conduct of racing on Saturday 13th November, for the BBIC Series '3 Island Race'.

For RPAYC boats that are a series entrant in the above mentioned RPAYC Series, as at Wednesday 10th November, **no additional entry will be required** with RMYC.

All boats entered into the above mentioned RPAYC series, are still required to complete a full crew list for the day's racing, for the applicable RPAYC Series via the SailSys entry platform.

Boats wishing to enter the entire Broken Bay Interclub Challenge Series, may make entry enquiries with Jaz Rowntree (RMYC) on 9998 5505.

For racing on Saturday 13th November, competitors are advised to note the Starting Time(s) *1050hrs and 1100hrs*, the different Starting & Finishing areas, plus the pre-determined course (3 Islands), as per the Sailing Instructions for the '3 Island Race', published by the RMYC <https://www.royalmotor.com.au/boating-groups/sailing/sailing-instructions-notice-of-race> .

Finish times from the BBIC will be applied to the above RPAYC Series.
