The Club is located in Newport, 45 minutes north of the CBD by road and 20NM by water.


The Club's marina is the largest Club marina in Australia and has an extensive range of storage opportunities, facilities and services including;

Vessel Arrival & Departure Times

Berth reservation arrival time is from 12pm and departure is required before 11am on the scheduled date of departure.

We ask visitors to let us know in advance if an earlier arrival, later departure, or if an extension is required, this enables us to manage all reservations efficiently.

Berth Assistance

On approach to the marina telephone the Club Reception on 02 9998 3700. State your vessel name and allocated berth. Whilst approaching, prepare berth lines and have fenders out.



Visitor Information

Reservation Procedures

The Club requires visitors to provide vessel details including; vessel name, make and specifications (length, beam and draft).

Pre-payment is required at the time of booking and insurance is required for all vessels brought onto the Club grounds. To guarantee your reservation please ensure payment and insurance is provided in advance.

Insurance

In the interest of providing protection to Club Members and visitors, the Club's License Agreement requires all vessels to be insured and the Club requires a copy.

Berth Assistance

The Waterfront team is on hand 7 days to provide berth assistance, and to assist visitors with any questions. To request berth assistance telephone Club Reception (02) 9998 3700 on approach to the marina, state your boat name and berth number.

Access Cards

Visitors can obtain a 24-hour facilities access card on arrival from Reception. This access card will provide access to the bathrooms, laundry and Crystal Street Car Park. A \$50 refundable deposit or credit card details are required. To return cards after hours, insert card into drop box located on wall (right) of Clubhouse entrance.

Shore Power & Connection Requirements

15amp shore power is available on the marina and 3 phase at select T Head berths.

Shore power leads connecting to the shore power must be marine grade, in good condition and must display an electrical tag to indicate the lead has been tested within 12 months. To view Ship to Shore Connection Policy <u>click here.</u>

Courtesy Trolleys

Courtesy Trolleys are available at the beginning of each marina arm within the trolley bays. The Club requests visitors return trolleys after use to designated trolley bays.

Ship To Shore Pump Out

Complimentary 'Ship to Shore' pump out is available for visitors on the Services Wharf located between "A" and "B" arms. 7 days with exception to Wednesday and Saturdays between 9am – 12.30pm. Clubhouse Bathroom & Laundry Access

Bathroom access is available and accessible after-hours with an 'access card' via lane way between Clubhouse and Boatyard.

The Laundry is open between the hours of 7am - 7pm (sharp) with payments required by credit card at the machine.

LPG Refills

Gas refills are available from the walkway to "B" marina/Service Wharf. Visitors must pay at Reception in advance. Gas bottles must be in good condition and be less than 10 years old. To request a refill see Reception

Recycling & Waste Management

Waste and recycling bins are located throughout the grounds. Waste disposal facilities are available for oil, oily rags and batteries only. The Club does not permit disposal of gas cylinders, fuel, paint, hazardous chemicals and bulk waste disposal is prohibited.

Security & CCTV

The Club operates continuous and ongoing (visual only) CCTV surveillance system within the clubhouse and throughout the club's facilities and grounds. Security Office is located off the north terrace of the Clubhouse and can be contacted 0493 844 360. Emergencies contact 000

Mail & Parcel Deliveries

Delivery of small items is accepted and must be addressed including boat name. Items can be sent direct to the Club via courier to 16 Mitala Street Newport 2106 or via post to; PO Box 99 Newport NSW 2106. Visitors who wish to arrange drop off or collection of large/bulky items are requested to contact the Club for approval.

Clubhouse Entry Requirements

Visitors are welcome enter and enjoy the Clubhouse facilities. Entry requirements include; visitors are required to sign in (ID required) Visitors who live within 5km require a Member to sign in, see Reception staff for assistance.

Chandlery

Riggtech Bosun's Locker, supplying all boating and merchandise needs is located in the Green Point Building at the main entrance to the Club. The Chandlery is open; Mon to Fri 8.30am - 5.00pm, Sat 9.00am - 3.00pm and Sun 9.00am -Midday

Visitor Parking

Ample parking is available for visitors at the Club. The Club has two parking options for visitors;

Top level Car Park (at Club) access available every day except Wednesday and Sunday's (Race Days)

Crystal Street Car Park (Crystal Street) access card required or via intercom 8am -5pm. Access to/from Club via walkway or foreshore.

Noise Restrictions

Visitors are urged to respect the Members right to the unaffected use of the facilities. Disrespectful, drunk or unruly behaviour will not be tolerated. The Club requires amplified music at a minimum & only audible on board. Sunday to Thursday all music must be turned off on vessels at 10pm. Friday and Saturday night music must be turned off by 11.30pm.

RPAYC is recognised as a leader in environmental practices and holds a 'Level 3 Clean Marina' accreditation and is a 5 Gold Anchor marina. We kindly ask visitors to ensure that you enjoy the facilities but undertake your boating activities with utmost respect for the environment.

All external contractors working anywhere on Club grounds are required to hold a current 'Marine Card', must meet the minimum requirements and must sign in / out. The Club reserves the right to refuse entry or ask Contractors to leave who do not meet the Clubs Contractor requirements. Emergencies can take many forms: fire, medical, bomb threat, explosion, assault, armed hold up, chemical spills or loss of essential services. It is important for Visitors to familiarise themselves and their guests with the Clubs Emergency Procedures.

In the event of an emergency alarm, announcement over the public address system or verbal instruction from any member, guest, staff or contractor must immediately cease work and proceed to the assembly area. The evacuation assembly sign is located at the middle car park, where personnel are to assemble near the sign.
