# The Royal Prince Alfred Yacht Club - Protest Hearing

Event: Saturday Winter Series Race 5 on 12 July 2025

Protestor 1: Gunner Goodwin represented by Robert Alpe Protestee 1: Shadow represented by Bruce Fergoson

#### Validity of the Protest:

The Protest Committee considered the validity of the protest in accordance with RRS 63.5 and declared it valid.

#### **FACTS FOUND:**

- 1. Wind was 6-8 knots, calm seas.
- 2. Both vessels were close hauled approaching the Rocky Point mark.
- 3. Gunner Goodwin was on Starbord Tack approaching the mark from 5 lengths out.
- 4. Shadow was on Port Tack approaching Gunner Goodwin.
- 5. Gunner Goodwin hailed Shadow.
- 6. Shadow then commenced to tack.
- 7. Gunner Goodwin then altered course to windward to avoid contact with Shadow prior to Shadow completing their tack.
- 8. This forced Gunner Goodwin to sail briefly above their proper course.
- 9. No contact occurred.
- 10. There was less than half a boatlength between both vessels after the manoeuvre with Shadow now overlapped and to leeward of Gunner Goodwin.

### **CONCLUSIONS:**

- 1. Shadow failed to Keep Clear of Gunner Goodwin.
- 2. Gunner Goodwin altered course to avoid contact.

## **DECISIONS**:

1. Shadow is disqualified.
