Our Club offers year-round inshore and offshore yacht racing, cruising, centreboard dinghy racing, sail training and courses.



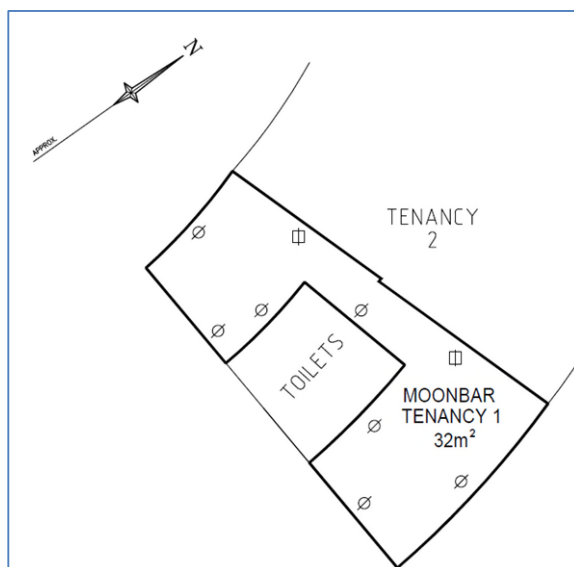
## The Layout – Office #1 ‘Moonbar’ Building

Positioned on the northern side of the Club within the historic Moonbar building, Office No. 1 offers a unique opportunity to establish your business in one of the Club’s most vibrant waterfront precincts.

Overlooking the centreboard lawn and marina, the office enjoys abundant natural light and a terrific western outlook over the marina, with close proximity to the Jack Gale Training Centre, centreboard storage facilities and marina.

Convenient access is available via Mitala Street, lift access from the Club car park and the centreboard stairs.

## Expression of Interest - Process

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Expressions of Interest are sought to ensure the Club continues to provide Members with high levels of service, industry expertise and competitive member focused pricing.

The process will identify applicants whose business operations and services align with the needs of Club Members, marina users and the Club's boatyard operations. The selection process will be conducted in three stages:

**Stage 1** submissions reviewed.

**Stage 2** submissions reviewed by Board.

**Stage 3** successful applicant contacted and Heads of Agreement signatory to proceed to lease preparation.

Applicants are encouraged to provide supporting documentation as appendices to their submission. Addressing the selection criteria in detail to assist the Club in fairly and efficiently comparing all applications received.

The Clubs' core selection criteria are set out below. No single criteria will dominate the selection process. The selection criteria will include:

- **Business' ability to add value and provide benefits to Members**

The club exists for its members. It is therefore critical that all businesses operating from the Club provide exclusive benefits to members including priority service and concessional pricing. Applicants must demonstrate their ability to deliver quality at a competitive price, priority and advantage to Members. It is expected applicants will commit to a pricing policy for the term of their tenancy.

- **Boatyard Operations**

The successful business may supply or provide services to Member and Non-Member boats on the Club's Boatyard which operates to a schedule which would require the applicant to prioritise works conducted on the Boatyard.

- **Proactive approach to Environmental & Work, Health & Safety**

Applicants must demonstrate an understanding and proactive of Environmental and Work, Health and Safety standards.

- **Track Record & Business Viability**

Applicants should demonstrate a successful track record in the proposed business. Applicants must demonstrate they have the financial resources and business skills to establish and maintain a viable business at the club.
